You may be aware from continuing media coverage that there is still no resolution between the government and the NEU over teachers' pay and conditions, and school funding. As a result, the Union have declared further strike action, which will take place next Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.

Wednesday 5th July: Reception Class will be closed. (Year 1[trip to Lower Moss Wood], 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 are open and children should attend as normal)

Friday 7th July: Reception Class, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will be closed. (Year 4, 5 and 6 are open and children should attend as normal)
